

- Your Trainee was automatically enrolled in DEERS.
- Spouse and/or children of your Trainee are eligible for DEERS enrollment.
- The service member is referred to as "the sponsor". Spouses and children are referredto as "dependents".
- If eligible for DEERS enrollment, you should receive a Form DD172 within 2-4 weeks, from your Trainee.
- Take the DD172 and the required documentation (see table to the right) toan ID cardoffice. (It does not need to be an Army office).
